THE COURSE MODULES, VENUES AND DATES

OPTION 1. THE WEEKEND MODULES

These modules, each covering 2 days, are taught within a period of one year. These have been arranged to take place on Saturdays and Sundays between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.

The next weekend modules option will take place in Wrexham Wellness, The Complementary Health Centre, Charles Street, Wrexham. The start date for this next course will be on 9/10 October 2010, followed by the following dates: 13/14 November; 11/12 December; 15/16 January 2011; 19/20 February; 19/20 March; 9/10 April; 14/15 May; 18/19 June and 9/10 July.

OPTION 2. THE 3 MONDAY TO FRIDAY BLOCKS

Each of these will start on the Monday at 2 p.m. and finish on the Friday at 1 p.m. The next opportunity to join this course for 2010/2011 will be on December 6 – 10, 2010; February 14 – 18, 2011 and April 11 – 15, 2011.

OPTION 3. THE INTENSIVE COURSE OPTION
